Week 2010 Description of Events (as of 3/11/10)

- ❖ **Wed. Dinner:** Dinner will be at “The Bank” Restaurant located in downtown Temecula. Menu is “open” and moderately priced.
- ❖ **Thurs. Julian Drive:** Scenic drive to Julian & lunch locally (*note lunch option @ Doffo below*).
- ❖ **Thurs. Gold Mine Tour:** Tour guides lead you through the intricate path of tunnels in the hard rock mine and share tales of the life of early residents of Julian.
- ❖ **Thurs. Vintage Motorbike Tour & Wine Tasting:** On the way back from Julian we can stop at “Doffo”. There will be 40 Vintage Motorcycles on display *with a light lunch* and wine tasting at **\$20/person**.
- ❖ **Thurs. Dinner:** Dinner will be at the “Gourmet Italian Restaurant. @ \$28/person including tax & tip, with a choice of three entrees, including salad, soft drinks or coffee & desert. *If you wish to “split” a dinner, a \$ fee will be collected on site.* The setting is classic with white linen and candlelight. The restaurant is within walking distance of the Hotel.
- ❖ **Fri. Fallbrook Drive:** We will gather in the morning and set off for a great drive through the back roads of San Diego County towards our destination of Fallbrook. Fallbrook is known as a quiet and pastoral community and is located not too many miles from the resort. The drive will allow for unique vistas and is a perfect route to set back and enjoy the sounds, sights and open road tranquility of Southern California. On arrival, we will have time for lunch and explore the local color of Fallbrook. Then back along a different route to our Hotel and in time for the next events.
- ❖ **Fri. Shopping Excursion & Lunch:** This Ladies event will begin around 10AM with a leisurely walk through Old Temecula, stopping at a store named Harmony for a floral demonstration. There will be plenty of time for shopping along the way before our English Tea at “Truffles and Lace”, finishing about 2PM. Cost is \$27 including tax & tip / *person. No “splits”*
- ❖ **Fri. Gymkhana:** This event will be held at the Lake Elsinore Diamond Stadium, home of the San Diego Padres affiliate about a 15 minute drive from the Hotel.. The parking area is the largest expanse of non-road pavement in the area. Vehicle Tech inspection will be at the hotel on Thurs and at the site on Friday. The Gymkhana course will be set up to be fun for the novice to navigate (much like driving a twisty country road), and also present a challenge to those wishing to drive it faster. Typical elapsed times will be less than 60 seconds and you most likely not get out of second gear. We will offer

practice runs followed by official timed runs. Trophies will be awarded at the Banquet on Saturday. Entry fee is **\$10/car/driver. (Two drivers =\$20)**

- ❖ **Fri Dinner & Glo Golf:** Enjoy the quiet and solitude of the golf course at Temecula Creek Inn.... What? No Way! Grab a golf club and laugh your way through the GLOWBALL GAMES! Everyone can be a golf pro on the special challenge course where we we'll take turns at events like, Closest to the Pin, Longest Put, Chip for accuracy...and more! They'll supply the dinner, clubs and glowballs, we supply the competitors!...\$30/person. ***If you wish to "split" a dinner, a \$ fee will be collected on site.***
- ❖ **Sat. Car Show & Lunch:** Car Show at South coast Winery...**lunch is included** for each registered member. Details forthcoming.
- ❖ **Sat. Craft Session:** Details forthcoming.
- ❖ **Sat. Tech Session:** The Tech Session is hosted by the Monise Family who has been active in building, repairing, restoring and racing British cars for over 50 years. Frank Monise Sr. began his business in 1949, and Frank Jr. took over from his dad in the 1990's. Now sons Geoff and Greg work with Frank and are themselves accomplished Vintage Racers.
- ❖ **Sat. Banquet:** The Banquet Dinner includes Coffee or Iced Tea, Artisan Rolls, Salad, **Choice of** Crushed Peppercorn Crusted New York Steak, w/Rich cabernet Sauvignon Sauce, Whole Grain Mustard Mashed Potato and Vegetable Napoleon **or** Grilled Salmon on a bed of Arugula and Spinach w/Butter Braised Fingerling Potatoes and Stuffed Baked Tomatoes followed by Desert. The cost of \$39/person includes sales tax and gratuity. (***no Split dinners***) Silent auction winners will be announced and Awards will be given.
- ❖ **Sun. Bkfst Farewell Meeting:** Raffle prizes will be announced and this will be the time to say our final good-byes except for those driving south to Escondido.
- ❖ **Sun. Auto Collection Tour:** The final event will be a tour of the Deer Park Winery, located at 29013 Champaign Blvd, Escondido. We will depart after Sunday breakfast around 9:30 and drive to Escondido. (About 30 miles So. of Temecula). Deer Park opens at 10 AM. The auto collection features over 100 vintage automobiles, plus motorcycles. Other collections include over 1000 antique appliances, historical wine making equipment, and Barbie dolls. Cost to tour is \$5/person. Wine tasting is \$5/person, waived with wine purchase. Picnic tables are available, but food is not sold on site.
